Discussion & Prayer Guide

After watching the message, we encourage you to walk through these questions and pray through these requests - either on your own or with those you are watching with.

Discussion Questions:

1. What has stood out to you the most from this series in Acts?
2. What do you feel like God is calling you to do as a result of what you've learned about who he is and who he calls his church to be?
3. Is Christ preeminent in your life? Is he the number one relationship you are pursuing and the number one message you are proclaiming? What other things vvy for that position in your life or in our world?
4. What fears do you have about being called beyond the walls of the church?
5. Who are the people and what are the places you are called to? Think about who is in your life, where you live, work and play, and burdens God has placed on your heart.
6. Have you experienced people showing up for you before, or having people to do life with? Why is having people to be on mission with so important? What is one step you can take to cultivate (or continue cultivating) biblical community in your life?

Pray For:

- **Spend some time thanking God** that he is good and faithful.
- **Pray God will draw you to himself and help you trust him** - pray for any specific areas you talked about that are hard for you to surrender.
- **Pray God will help you keep Christ preeminent** in your life and help you surrender the things or messages that you put before him.
- **Pray that God will give you courage to go beyond the walls** and to pray for and share Jesus with the people and in the places you've been called.
- **Pray that God will help you cultivate biblical community with people** that is characterized by generosity, diversity and being on mission together.
- **Pray for the family and friends of George Floyd** as they grieve, pray for our nation and pray for the church - that there would be lament, that there would be repentance and that we would reflect the love and light of Jesus in a broken world by loving one another well and standing with one another.
- **Pray for people who are sick with COVID-19** to be healed, **those who have lost loved ones** to COVID-19, **medical professionals** who are treating them, and **medical researchers** who are seeking a cure.
- **Pray for first responders and political leaders** as they serve, lead and make decisions through the COVID-19 pandemic.
